How do you get started?

Every community led housing scheme starts from a different first point. Listed below are some of the steps you will need to tick off on your journey, though not necessarily in the order shown.

Bring together a group of interested people to lead the project.
Establish local housing need.
Visit or talk to other communities to see how they have done it.
Decide on the right community led housing model and housing mix for your area.
Consult with your community and gain their support.
Find a suitable piece of land or existing building.
Talk to the local authority about planning and help.
Raise initial finance for feasibility work.
Prepare a business plan and budget.
Become a legal entity.
Design your housing.
Raise finance for the build.
Secure planning permission.
Tender the building work.



Manage and maintain the new homes.

What is community led housing?

Community led housing schemes are:

- Homes built and owned by the community for the long term benefit of the community – whether that's income from rents going straight into the community purse, or homes for sale being kept at affordable prices.
- Run by a local, independent and not for profit organisation – sometimes specially created for the purpose of building affordable homes.
- Dedicated communities coming together to build appropriate homes for local people.
- Housing developments where key decisions on new homes are made by the community - from finding the most suitable site, through design, to deciding who moves in.
- Democratic and accountable to the wider community.
